## ACT I - 5 OUNCE

MV **DELAMOTTE** *Champagne, Brut, Le Mesnil-sur-Oger, Côte des Blancs, France*

We are thrilled to begin the evening with bubbles from one of our favorite houses. This wine is predominantly grand cru Chardonnay. Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier are added to finish the personality of the wine. The finish is elegant and perfectly balanced with notes of white flesh fruit, pear, and ginger.

## ACT II - 4 OUNCE

2015 **EYRIE** *Pinot Gris, Dundee Hills, Oregon*

For your Asparagus Ravioli we present this delightful glass that features aromatic notes of spring greens. The palate boasts of pomme fruits and crushed fennel that play well with the Roasted Asparagus and Nantes Carrot. It has a strong backbone of acidity while maintaining a soft, round texture.

## ACT III - 4 OUNCE

2016 **NELLCÔTE** *Rosé, Mt. Veeder, Napa Valley*

This Rose is made from Malbec and Syrah grapes and is an absolute treasure. The wine has a dry complexity while showing off notes of strawberry and bright red cherries. They give way to the sweetness of the Shallot-Basted Scallop, and the medium body of the wine is simply perfect with the Prosciutto.

## ACT IV - 4 OUNCE

2015 **APHROS** *Loureiro, Vinho Verde, Minho, Portugal*

It is with great delight that we pour this unique varietal that comes from Portugal. Notes of green apple and Bosc pears play well to the Smoke-Roasted Poussin. The Creamy Artichoke Cous Cous is met with a mouth-watering acidity and a breadth of mineral that beckons you to enjoy another bite.

## ACT V - 4 OUNCE

2015 **ANDREW WILL** *Merlot, Columbia Valley, Washington*

Onto the red! And we were sure to present you with one that is a surefire knockout, as it is loaded with ripe blackberries and dark cherries. Tannins bind to your protein, providing a burst of flavor and a plush texture that coats the palate, playing nicely to the Fondant and White Asparagus.

## ACT VI - 2 OUNCE

2013 **ANAM CARA** *Late Harvest Gewurztraminer, Nicholas Estate, Chehalem Mountains, Oregon*

We finish with a scrumptious treat for our palate. Layers of honey, ripe peach, and juicy nectarine deliver quite the finale to be had with the Coconut Pavlova. The sweetness of the wine is the perfect complement to the Pineapple and Yuzu Sabayon.

## ACT I - 5 OUNCE

MV **DELAMOTTE** *Champagne, Brut, Le Mesnil-sur-Oger, Côte des Blancs, France*

We are thrilled to begin the evening with bubbles from one of our favorite houses. This wine is predominantly grand cru Chardonnay. Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier are added to finish the personality of the wine. The finish is elegant and perfectly balanced with notes of white flesh fruit, pear, and ginger.

## ACT II - 4 OUNCE

2015 **LA SCOLCA** *Cortese, Gavi, Piedmont, Italy*

Your first still wine this evening features notes of green apple, lemon citrus, and white flowers that dance with the Asparagus Ravioli. The wine is dry with a medium body and zing of acidity that makes it perfect with the creaminess of the Egg Yolk and the earthiness of the Black Trumpet Mushrooms.

## ACT III - 4 OUNCE

2015 **ELENA WALCH** *White Blend, Beyond the Clouds, Alto Adige, Italy*

We are very excited to show off this unique blend, predominantly Chardonnay. Don't let the name fool you, this is not your typical Chardonnay. The wine is beautifully aromatic with notes of pineapple and rose petals that are perfect with the Scallop. The palate is creamy and elegant with a ton of complexity that works well with the English Peas and Prosciutto.

## ACT IV - 4 OUNCE

2015 **TERRE BIANCHE** *Pigato, Riviera Ligure di Ponente, Liguria, Italy*

Also known as Vermentino, this wine is sure to be a hit with the Poussin. The name Pigato, means spotted, and it refers to the little rusty tones that appear on the grape upon advanced maturation. The wine has notes of peach and aromatic herbs that lend itself to the Preserved Citrus. The acidic backbone of the wine plays well with the Artichoke Pearl Cous Cous.

## ACT V - 4 OUNCE

2010 **ARCANUM** *Red Blend, Valadorna, Tuscany, Italy*

This Merlot based Tuscan blend is absolutely stunning. Dark berries and a nice tannic structure lend this wine to be a great complement with the Tenderloin. Dried herbs and toasted baking spices are beautiful next to the Fondant and White Asparagus. The texture of the wine is just soft enough to pay homage to this course.

## ACT VI - 2 OUNCE

2005 **CHÂTEAU RIEUSSEC** *Late Harvest White Blend, Sauternes, France*

We come to a magnificent close to the evening with this lovely glass. Notes of candied apricots and dried figs are perfect with the Coconut Pavlova. The finish is long and rich, with robust components of sweet fruit.
