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# HOUSE WINE PAIRING

## ACT I - 5 OUNCE

MV **DELAMOTTE** *Champagne, Brut, Le Mesnil-sur-Oger, Côte des Blancs, France*

We are thrilled to begin the evening with bubbles from one of our favorite houses. This wine is predominantly grand cru Chardonnay. Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier are added to finish the personality of the wine. The finish is elegant and perfectly balanced with notes of white flesh fruit, pear, and ginger.

## ACT II - 4 OUNCE

2016 **LICIA** *Albariño, Rias Baixas, Spain*

Licia is a shortening of Galicia, the autonomía in northwest Spain known for its Celtic influence and overall greenness due to the maritime climate. Notes of grapefruit, quince jelly, and fresh herbs greet the nose and complement the Hawaiian swordfish. The palate offers flavors of citrus and green apple that pair nicely with the orchard fruits and almonds.

## ACT III - 4 OUNCE

2015 **GREGORY GRAHAM** *Chardonnay, Sangiacomo Vineyard, Carneros*

Greg Graham was once the winemaker at Rombauer. In 1992, he started his own label. This Chardonnay is rich with flavors of vanilla and creamed corn – the perfect accompaniment to the corn agnolotti and the wild pecan butter. This classic California style, oaky and buttery, is a complement to Act III this evening.

## ACT IV - 4 OUNCE

2016 **CASTELLO DI NEIVE** *Pinot Nero, i Cortini Vineyard, Langhe, Piedmont, Italy*

This wine is loaded with cherries and cranberries with undertones of earth and tobacco. It pays homage to the duck breast and the cherries on this dish. The estate has been producing since 1964 when Giacomo Stupino decided to capitalize on his experience as a site surveyor and started purchasing favorable vineyard sites, such as this one.

## ACT V - 4 OUNCE

2011 **VALDUERO** *Tempranillo, Reserva, Ribera Del Duero, Spain*

From one of our favorite producers, we present this delightful red that shows off its dark red cherries, cedar, and dill. Aged for a minimum of 30 months in a variety of barrels, this wine has just a hint of leather making it excellent alongside the peppered beef and morel mushrooms. Another knockout of a wine from Yolanda Garcia Viadero.

## ACT VI - 2 OUNCE

2016 **SCHLOSS LIESER** *Riesling, Kabinett, Piesporter Goldtröpfchen, Mosel, Germany*

With aromas of passion fruit, ripe peach, and honeysuckle, this wine is a homerun when enjoyed with the frangipane and apricot tarte. The wine is elegant and juicy and is a great way to finish off a warm summer evening. Cheers!

## ACT I - 5 OUNCE

MV **DELAMOTTE** *Champagne, Brut, Le Mesnil-sur-Oger, Côte des Blancs, France*

We are thrilled to begin the evening with bubbles from one of our favorite houses. This wine is predominantly grand cru Chardonnay. Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier are added to finish the personality of the wine. The finish is elegant and perfectly balanced with notes of white flesh fruit, pear, and ginger.

## ACT II - 4 OUNCE

2016 **MARISA CUOMO** *Blend, Ravello, Costa D'Amalfi, Campania, Italy*

If you search for images of Ravello, Italy, you will be greeted by stunning pictures of the Amalfi Coast. We greet your dinner tonight with this blend of Falanghina and Biancolella from that very region. Notes of honeysuckle and fresh-cut daisy jump out to dance with the Hawaiian spearfish. The wine is light in body, with a good acidic backbone, and a stony minerality that is perfect with the orchard fruits and almonds.

## ACT III - 4 OUNCE

2015 **HENRI & GILLES BUISSON** *Chardonnay, La Perrière, Saint Romain, France*

Franck and Frederick Buisson pay homage to their family history of farming that dates all the way back to the 1100s. This wine is a true gem, with intense limestone aromas. The palate is rich with Gala apples and Bosc pears that are impeccable alongside the corn agnolotti and the wild pecan butter.

## ACT IV - 4 OUNCE

2014 **MAISON HARBOUR** *Pinot Noir, La Justice, Gevrey Chambertin, France*

Nicholas and Colleen literally quit their jobs and moved to France to pursue their passion for wine. Nicholas studied winemaking and Colleen studied the marketing aspect behind wine. Together they present us with this stunning glass that features aromas of forest floor and a palate that features mushrooms and just a hint of ripe cherry. This is a beautiful accompaniment to the Duck Breast.

## ACT V - 4 OUNCE

2015 **JULIEN PILON** *Syrah, L'Élégance du Caillou, Cornas, Rhone Valley, France*

Julien Pilon described himself as a landless winemaker when he started on his own in 2010. Flavors of ripe cherry and black raspberry give way to notes of pepper and spice that play well with the peppered beef and morel mushrooms. The tannins are soft and luscious, providing a nice texture to complement the gold 'fondue'.

## ACT VI - 2 OUNCE

2014 **CHÂTEAU FILHOT** *Late Harvest White Blend, Sauternes, France*

This estate was founded in 1709 and is still making delicious, botrytized wines that we will enjoy with the frangipane and apricot tarte. Ripe and honeyed notes of nectar and apricot lend themselves to your dessert. The wine has a nice acidity that is refreshing for the palate, bite after bite, sip after sip.
