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# HOUSE WINE PAIRING

## ACT I - 5 OUNCE

MV **LAURENT PERRIER** *Champagne, Brut, La Cuvée, Tours Sur Marne, France*

We are thrilled to begin the evening with bubbles from one of our favorite houses. This wine is predominantly Chardonnay. Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier are added to finish the personality of the wine. The finish is elegant and perfectly balanced with notes of white flesh fruit, peach, and lemon zest.

## ACT II - 4 OUNCE

2017 **PERLAGE** *Pinot Grigio, Delle Venezie, Italy*

The Perlage estate was founded in 1985 by the 7 Nardi brothers. Since the beginning, the house has been known for their certified organic wines. This wine opens with a hint of sour peach and wild strawberry on the nose that plays off of the hint of spice from the Poblano Crema. The palate shows light fruit notes of pears and peaches. The finish has an acidity to complement the Pumpkin Agnolotti.

## ACT III - 4 OUNCE

2016 **EDEN RIFT** *Pinot Noir, Cienega Valley*

Eden Rift is among the oldest, continually producing estate vineyards in California. It is no surprise why we are enamored with this wine. It is perfect to stand up to the combination of flavors and textures in this Act. The notes of pomegranate and blackberry are interlaced with inklings of black tea and baking spice, making it fantastic with the Porcini and Truffle Beurre Blanc.

## ACT IV - 4 OUNCE

2017 **PIERRE SPARR** *Riesling, Alsace, France*

This beautiful glass comes from a winery that was founded in 1680 and has been in the Sparr family the entire time, passed down through nine successive generations. We begin with aromas of citrus and peach. The first sip delivers a dry, fresh, and balanced experience tailored perfectly for the Southern Fried Poussin and Bourbon Maple Sauce.

## ACT V - 4 OUNCE

2013 **TINTONEGRO** *Malbec, El Limo, Finca La Escuela, Mendoza, Argentina*

Tinto Negro, or "Black Wine," is a collaboration between Alejandro Sejanovich and Jeff Mausbach, colleagues at Catena Zapata for fifteen years. Their commitment to sharing specific expressions of Malbec is nothing short of inspiring. The glass is full bodied, with big, grippy tannins that are laced with flavors of raspberry and violet, perfect for the Lamb Shank.

## ACT VI - 2 OUNCE

2014 **NACINA** *Gewurztraminer, Wein der Eisbox, Danny's Vineyard, Monterey County*

For your final act, we present this delicious supplement to your Pumpkin Mousse and Dulce de Leche. Intense notes of lychee, dried apricot, and exotic spices strike the palate in the most fantastic way. Underlying notes of clove and cinnamon play well with the Coffee Kataifi and Spiced Cashews. Cheers!

## ACT I - 5 OUNCE

MV **LAURENT PERRIER** *Champagne, Brut, La Cuvée, Tours Sur Marne, France*

We are thrilled to begin the evening with bubbles from one of our favorite houses. This wine is predominantly Chardonnay. Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier are added to finish the personality of the wine. The finish is elegant and perfectly balanced with notes of white flesh fruit, peach, and lemon zest.

## ACT II - 4 OUNCE

2016 **OTTIN** *Petite Arvine, Valle d'Aosta, Italy*

The Ottin family has been growing grapes for generations. It wasn't until 2007, that Elio decided to take vinification into his own hands – and are we glad he did! Aromas of pear blossom give way to a soft and delicate texture that is intertwined with flavors of pineapple and rhubarb. There is a long finish that sits well with the Pumpkin Agnolotti and Poblano Crema.

## ACT III - 4 OUNCE

2016 **SAINTSBURY** *Pinot Noir, Donnelly Creek, Anderson Valley*

In 1977, David Graves and Richard Ward met each other in brewing class at UC Davis. They quickly found that they shared a love for Burgundian wines, and a few years later they opened shop. This wine is loaded with notes of dark cherry, bittersweet chocolate, and baking spice, all of which will highlight the Steelhead and really bring out the magic in the Porcini and Truffle Beurre Blanc.

## ACT IV - 4 OUNCE

2010 **MONTUS** *Blanc, Pacherenc du Vic Bilh, France*

This organic and vegan wine is comprised of two unique varietals, Petit Manseng and Petit Courbu. Alain Brumont, winemaker, is regarded as one of the best winemakers in the world. This wine is complex, meaning there are tons of layers of flavors ranging from passionfruit, hazelnut, and fennel herbs. It is incredible alongside the Fried Poussin and Bourbon Maple Sauce.

## ACT V - 4 OUNCE

2015 **BELL** *Syrah, Canterbury Vineyard, Block 6, Sierra Foothills*

Anthony Bell and his team put a lot of emphasis on the vineyard management aspect of winemaking. The motto is that good wine comes from the vineyard. As a result, this wine has layers of sweet spice wrapped in a velvety texture. It is juicy and supple with flavors of black plum and boysenberry, which pay homage to the Lamb Shank and Creamy Polenta.

## ACT VI - 2 OUNCE

2006 **LUCIGNANO** *Vin Santo del Chianti, Tuscany, Italy*

This is an absolute fantastic close to the evening. This Vin Santo, or Holy Wine, is laced with dried fruit notes of apricot and peach. The hint of honey carries with it a complex spice that lingers and dances with the Coffee Kataifi and Spiced Cashews. The acidic backbone plays well to the Pumpkin Mousse.
