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# HOUSE WINE PAIRING

## ACT I - 5 OUNCE

MV **LAURENT PERRIER** *Champagne, Brut, La Cuvée, Tours Sur Marne, France*

We are thrilled to begin the evening with bubbles from one of our favorite houses. This wine is predominantly Chardonnay. Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier are added to finish the personality of the wine. The finish is elegant and perfectly balanced with notes of white flesh fruit, peach, and lemon zest.

## ACT II - 4 OUNCE

2017 **VIÑÁTIGO** *Listan Blanco, Tenerife, Canary Islands, Spain*

There is an extensive amount of work that goes into wine production on the Canary Islands. Grown at 460 meters above sea level and pergola-trained vines that average 100 years old, so you can experience this pairing. Notes of fennel and dried fruit are supported by acidity that is perfect for the Hawaiian Walu and Green Curry Beurre Blanc.

## ACT III - 4 OUNCE

2017 **EIGHTEEN VINES** *Chardonnay, Catie's Corner Vineyard, Russian River Valley*

Made by a friend, Drew Scolaro, we were more than happy to find a home for this stunning Chardonnay in our program. The soil, known as Goldridge, is a sandy loam that is accompanied by a cool, maritime climate. The wine has a full body, but steers clear of the typical California style of oak and butter. Instead, tropical fruits take the spotlight and the backbone of acidity is perfect for the White Prawns and Creamy Parmesan Grits.

## ACT IV - 4 OUNCE

2016 **KELLEY FOX** *Pinot Noir, Ahurani, McMinnville, Oregon*

Kelley Fox produces Burgundian style Pinot Noirs and gained much of her influence by David Lett, pioneer of Oregon wine. Farming practices at Momtazi Vineyard is all biodynamic. That translates into a glass riddled with notes of fresh herbs and forest floor. Those same notes make for a spectacular experience when enjoyed with the Pierogi, Truffle Butter Brussels, and Chanterelle Mushrooms.

## ACT V - 4 OUNCE

2016 **CHAPPELLET** *Red Blend, Mountain Cuvée, Napa & Sonoma County*

This beautiful wine comes from the house that put Pritchard Hill into legendary status. Founded in 1966, Don Chappellet was guided by Andre Tchelistcheff, and the estate has forever been founded on the love for the vineyard. The result in this particular Bordeaux blend is vanilla, ripe plum, and blackberries. It is perfect alongside the Beef Tenderloin, Gratin, and Creamed Spinach.

## ACT VI - 2 OUNCE

MV **MENÉRES** *Fine Ruby Port, Douro, Portugal*

Menéres is currently into the 14th generation of the van Zeller family, making it the longest unbroken "dynasty" in the Portuguese wine trade. This is a blend of younger ports, made from the Touriga Franca, Tinta Roriz, Tinta Barroca, and Tinto Cao varietals. They are aged in large oak vats, or tonels, and are rich with plum and raspberry flavors. Notes of dark fruit give way to the Dark Chocolate Mochi.

## ACT I - 5 OUNCE

MV **LAURENT PERRIER** *Champagne, Brut, La Cuvée, Tours Sur Marne, France*

We are thrilled to begin the evening with bubbles from one of our favorite houses. This wine is predominantly Chardonnay. Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier are added to finish the personality of the wine. The finish is elegant and perfectly balanced with notes of white flesh fruit, peach, and lemon zest.

## ACT II - 4 OUNCE

2015 **RAINER WESS** *Grüner Veltliner, Pfaffenberg, Kremstal, Austria*

Rainer Wess produces his wine sustainably. While not certified, many of the farming practices mimic that of an organic vineyard. The soil is composed of loam and silt, locally known as loess, and produces a round, yet bright and juicy wine. It is quite like biting into a Mirabelle plum in the middle of summer. This ripe fruit has a foundation of acidity, perfect for the Green Curry Beurre Blanc and Walu.

## ACT III - 4 OUNCE

2005 **DANIEL ETIENNE DEFAIX** *Chardonnay, Les Lys, 1er Cru, Chablis, France*

The Defaix family roots dig way back, well into the 16th century. Today, Daniel Etienne maintains the family's name in viticulture. You do not really grasp how special the estate is until someone hands you a glass that was harvested 13 years ago, and proceeds to tell you that it is their current release. Hints of bergamot and acacia play well with the White Prawns and Creamy Parmesan Grits.

## ACT IV - 4 OUNCE

2015 **MARTIN FAUDOT** *Trousseau, Arbois, Jura, France*

In the Jura, south of Alsace, only three red varietals are grown and produced. Pinot Noir, Poulsard, and Trousseau are often used to make blended reds. This is special as Michel Faudot and Jean Pierre Martin present us with this 100% Trousseau. It is riddled with notes of elderberry, gooseberry, and forest floor mushroom making it perfect to enjoy alongside the Pierogi that features Chanterelle Mushrooms and Truffle Butter Brussels.

## ACT V - 4 OUNCE

2015 **ORNELLAIA** *Red Blend, Le Serre Nuove dell'Ornellaia, Bolgheri, Tuscany, Italy*

Ornellaia, as an estate, is amongst the leaders of what we now know to be the Super Tuscan. This "second vin" is a Merlot based Bordeaux style blend, made from the younger vineyards of the estate. Intense and ripe notes of blueberry and blackberry are accompanied by a subtle touch of baking spice. Bold, yet balanced, to make a fantastic companion with the Beef Tenderloin and Creamed Spinach.

## ACT VI - 2 OUNCE

2014 **BEAURENARD** *Grenache, VDN, Rasteau, Rhone, France*

Located in the Châteauneuf du Pape, Bearenard is currently into the 7th generation of being a family run estate. Daniel and Frédéric Coulon grow this Grenache in Rasteau, on well exposed terraces of stony, clay-chalk soil. The grapes are harvested when incredibly ripe, containing more than 260 grams of natural sugar per litre before alcohol is added to arrest fermentation. It is filled with dark and rich plum flavors perfect for the Chocolate Butter Mochi.
