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# HOUSE WINE PAIRING

## ACT I - 5 OUNCE

MV **DELAMOTTE** *Champagne, Brut, Le Mesnil-sur-Oger, Côte des Blancs France*

We are thrilled to begin the evening with bubbles from one of our favorite houses. This wine is predominantly Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, and Pinot Meunier are added to finish the personality of the wine. The finish is elegant and perfectly balanced with notes of white flesh fruit, peach, and lemon zest.

## ACT II - 4 OUNCE

2016 **PAZO BARRANTES** *Albariño, Rias Baixas, Spain*

The Pazo de Barrantes estate in Rias Baixas, Spain and its winemaking history dates back to 1511. It is currently being run by two siblings Chus Suarez Llanos and Vicente Cebrián. The wines from the Pazo de Barrantes estate are rumored to be some of the first white wines grown in this region. Aromas of fresh yellow lemons and flowers meet the cilantro with a clean freshness. The wonderful acidity and long finish of this wine pairs remarkably with the creamy avocado.

## ACT III - 4 OUNCE

2015 **PATA NEGRA** *Verdejo, Rueda, Spain*

The winemaking of Rueda dates back to the 11th century and Pata Negra is a wonderful example of preserving that tradition. The Verdejo grape was almost completely wiped out from the phylloxera outbreak of the 1800's. Gaining popularity in the 1970's the Verdejo grape has made a full recovery, thanks to the help of many small producers in the Rueda region such as Pata Negra. Noted for its balance of acid and fresh fruit it makes for a wonderful pairing with the cilantro and lychee.

## ACT IV - 4 OUNCE

2018 **DOS MINAS** *Malbec, Cafayate, Salta, Argentina*

Old Argentinian slang for girl is Mina. So here we have Dos Minas, or two girls. Lucia Romero from Argentina and Heather Willens from Los Angeles run this almost 6000 ft elevation winery from the high valley of Cafayate in the Northwest of Argentina. This structured Malbec offers dark plums on the nose. Having a nice backbone of tannins the wine is an unctuous selection for the slow roasted pork tamale.

## ACT V - 4 OUNCE

2012 **GOMEZ CRUZADO** *Reserva Rioja, La Rioja, Spain*

Gómez Cruzado winery dates back to 1886 and is currently run by David González and Juan Antonio Leza. This winery is located at the world famous Barrio de la Estación which is the train that travels through the historical winemaking region of Rioja. This wine has an undeniable Old World feel to it. Bold and fruity, yet balanced with a silky elegance. A true hero to stand up to the beef short rib's decadence.

## ACT VI - 2 OUNCE

2015 **LA FLEUR D'OR** *Sauternes, France*

Bill Blatch is a négociant that purchases high quality grapes from lesser, well-known classified parcels throughout the Sauternes region of Bordeaux. Bill consistently produces rich elegant yellow colored wines that smell like apricot orchards and orange blossoms. The flavors are full and vivacious on the palate with apricots and fresh honey, which is balanced by the wines zingy acidity.

## ACT I - 5 OUNCE

MV **DELAMOTTE** *Champagne, Brut, Le Mesnil-sur-Oger, Côte des Blancs France*

We are thrilled to begin the evening with bubbles from one of our favorite houses. This wine is predominantly Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, and Pinot Meunier are added to finish the personality of the wine. The finish is elegant and perfectly balanced with notes of white flesh fruit, peach, and lemon zest.

## ACT II - 4 OUNCE

2014 **BUÇACO BRANCO**, *Blend, Dão-Bairrada, Portugal*

Since 1917, Bucaco Branco & Tinto were designed to blend two regions, Dão and Bairrada. This distinct blend became an object of culture, limited to kings, queens, heads of state and to the world famous Bussaco Palace Hotel itself. Tonight's symbol of nobility compliments our scallop ceviche course by balancing extravagance with lightning bolt acidity. A pairing fit for a queen or king!

## ACT III - 4 OUNCE

2011 **MESTRES**, *Cava Gran Reserva, Brut Nature, "Visol," Catalonia, Spain*

The Mestres family takes great pride in tradition, enough for its current owners to be the 30th generation of winegrowers and winemakers. In 1945, their Visol bottle was the first Cava ever sold without the addition of dosage after disgorgement. To pair with our tuna arepa, Visol's continued tradition will share a uniquely savory quality coupled with mineral driven persistence.

## ACT IV - 4 OUNCE

2016 **ALTOS LAS HORMIGAS**, *Malbec, Gualtallary, Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina*

Immediately impressed during a spontaneous trip to Argentina, founders Albert and Antonio created Altos Las Hormigas with a focus on terrior. They share a firm belief that each intervention in wine is a step away from origin. The result is a wine with an uncanny sense of place. As such, tonight's Gualtallary-based Malbec provides fresh acidity and tempered alcohol; two characteristics pivotal to pairing with our unique take of tamale.

## ACT V - 4 OUNCE

2016 **ARTADI** *Monastrell, "El Sequé," Alicante, Spain*

This Monastrell comes from the prestigious Artadi house. Known for Rioja, their second property in Valencia, Spain produces wines with strong maritime influence just miles away from the Mediterranean. This wine has intense red berries on the nose and palate gives way to finesse driven spices of dried sage and pink peppercorns. The soft tannins and lower alcohol makes this a perfect food pairing with the mole beef short rib.

## ACT VI - 2 OUNCE

MV **VALDESPINO**, *Oloroso, "Don Gonzalo," VOS, Jerez, Spain*

Akin to our previous Mestres family, Bodega Valdespino has winemaking roots tracing back to the 13th century. Valdespino may hold traditional methods, but unlike most sherry producers, they equally stress an importance in terrior, owning more than 186 hectares. Tonight's "Don Gonzalo" oloroso sherry could benefit no dish better than our luscious take of tres leche cake. Harmonizing aromas of hazelnuts and Cuban cigars, "Don Gonzalo" flamencos between the ever-desired dessert and the ever-needed digestif.
